

IS YOUR CHILD READY FOR JUNIOR GOLF?

Most children are ready to participate in a Junior Golf Program at about the age of eight. However, “readiness” varies widely from individual to individual.

The following ten questions will help you with measuring your child’s “readiness”:

1. Is your child showing a GENUINE interest in golf? (or do Mom and Dad want junior to play more than junior does?)
2. Does your child understand the seriousness of the safety issues with golf? (primarily swinging clubs close to another person.)
3. Have you spent time teaching your child the basic stance and grip? (Child can put tee in, take a stance, and grip WITHOUT your assistance?)
4. Have you spent time teaching your child the rules of etiquette and course care? (Replace divot, no running on tees and greens, ready golf, honors, etc.)
5. Is your child patient enough to wait for his/her turn to hit?
6. Will the child’s attention span be long enough to listen to brief instructions and lessons with the pro?
7. Does the child make ball contact the majority of the time?
8. Has the child developed enough strength to swing a golf club and CARRY HIS/HER OWN equipment? (And walk the course without getting too tired?)
9. Is the child dependent enough, that if the “walker” s/he is assigned to is not his/her parent or grandparent, s/he will not be upset?
10. Have you spent time golfing with your child and taken him/her to hit practice balls and putt?

JUNIOR GOLF 2023 HANDBOOK

Welcome to the 2023 Junior Golf Program at Creekside Golf Club!

OBJECTIVES

DRESS CODE

Applies to all juniors & adults in the Clubhouse and on the course.

Everyone:

1. Conventional golf attire shall be worn at all times on all parts of the golf course.
2. No jeans will be permitted on the golf course. Jeans ARE permitted on the driving range, putting green and in our dining areas. JEANS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON PLAY NIGHTS.
3. Shorts must be reasonable and proper walking shorts of mid-thigh length only. Athletic shorts (ie: jogging, tennis, cut-offs, spandex, or swim type, tank tops, or tee shirts, etc.) are not permitted.
4. Only golf shoes with soft spikes or flat soled shoes are permitted on the golf course.

Boys:

Neat clean pants, slacks, cords, or appropriate tailored shorts are acceptable as are sweaters, sweatshirts, mock turtlenecks, turtlenecks, and of course golf shirts. Tank tops and underwear-type tee shirts and screenprint-type tee shirts are not acceptable. Hats must be worn with the bill facing forward.

Girls:

Shorts are to be of reasonable length. Tank tops, bare midriffs, halter tops, or strapless tops, underwear-type and screenprint-type logo tee shirts are not acceptable.
